Aletha I. LaVigne, age 97, of Kalamazoo, passed away April 27, 2015 at Stanford Lodge in Plainwell. Aletha was born September 30, 1917 in Fort Wayne, IN the daughter of Fred and Myrtle (Howe) Neal and graduated from Grand Ledge high School in 1935, and Denver Bible Institute in 1940. In 1949 she married James LaVigne, who preceded her in death in 1962. Aletha worked as secretary for the Kalamazoo Stove Company, was a medical secretary for 8 years and court reporter at Percy Jones Hospital in Battle Creek. Then she was legal secretary for Austin Doyle and then for Attorney Ned Deming where she retired in 1980.
