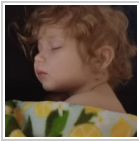

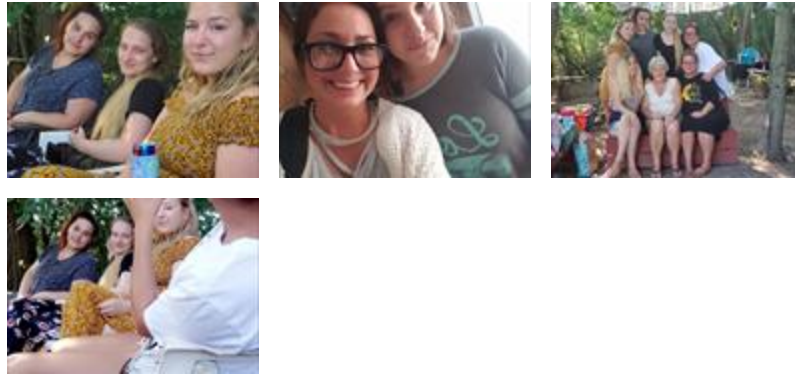

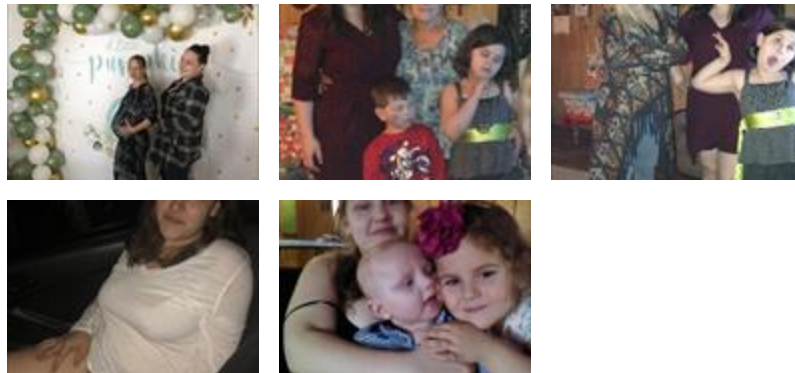
She was so kind and soft spoken and had the biggest heart I'll never forget your laugh and I'm so sad that time with you was cut short but I will forever cherish our memories 💧
