Passed away Saturday, April 1, 2017. Ann was born February 26, 1939 in Plainwell, the daughter of the late Carl and Mildred Wahmhoff and had lived in the Bangor area since 1961. Ann was very involved in her church where she volunteered for Christian Service, St. Vincent De Paul, Daughters of Mary and many other programs. She had worked for Bangor Public Schools as the Food Service Manager where she became famous for her chocolate chip cookies. Ann also volunteered for hospice and the South Haven Hospital coffee shop.
