Arthur E. Morgan went home to be with his Lord on May 4, 2016. Arthur was born on April 4, 1922 in Chicago, IL. He was the son of Milton Edward Morgan, who died on October 29, 1936, when Arthur was 14 years old, and Clara Lucille Morgan Berggren, who died on March 25, 2004. His stepfather, Edward Berggren, died September 10, 1979. Also preceding him in death was his wife, Martina, whom he married November 6, 1965; daughter, Susan Morgan; and two sisters, Daisy and Margaret. Surviving is his wife, Shirley; 2 daughters, Gaye Levian and Penny Oranje; two grandsons, Jimmijon Robbins and David Levian; two great grandsons, Aiden and Ethan Robbins; a great granddaughter Katlynn Levian. Arthur had been a truck driver for over 65 years, including Doyle Freight Lines, Great Lakes Express, Alvan Motor Freight Lines and Blue Arrow/Douglas Freight Lines. He served in the Armed Forces for three years during World War II where he also drove truck. Two of those years he served overseas in the European Theatre, Normandy Invasion, Battle of the Bulge, Rhineland-Remagen Bridge; Northern France and Central Europe. He was a member of Teamsters Union and a member of American Legion. He enjoyed working on and restoring old cars. He was a member of the Kalamazoo Antique Automobile Restoration Club.
