Her career spanned thirty years and included hospital floor work, home health, hospice and pediatric care. She loved her work and her patients, and she worked to keep her family healthy as well.

Barbara was an inspiration to many people around her, especially her sons. She encouraged her younger son, Kermit, to attend medical school and her older son, Oliver, to become a political science professor. She was a wife, mother, grandmother and friend but most of all she will always be

remembered as a woman who cared deeply about helping others. Whether it was her family or friends, she always took the time to listen and try to help those around her. She was a hard-working, strong and confident woman who always wanted the best for her kids and grandchildren.
