



## Betty Elizabeth Haney

May 8, 1927 - December 9, 2020

Betty Elizabeth Haney, aged 93, passed away December 9, 2020, at Graceway at Countryside, South Haven, MI. She was born to William and Flora (Wright) Starkey on May 8, 1927, in Greenville, MI. At age 12 Betty was adopted by James and Nancy (Burrell) Lynch of Bangor, MI. On July 16, 1949, Betty was united in marriage with Marshall E. Haney at Simpson United Methodist Church, Bangor. They spent many happy evenings dancing with local square-dancing groups and were also members of the Oddfellows Hall. During their marriage, Betty alternately was a homemaker and worked at Adams Electronics in Bangor. Marshall and Betty were long-time members of Bangor Free Methodist Church.
