Passed away Tuesday, January 20, 2015 at White Oaks Retirement Residence, Lawton. Bev was born November 6, 1927 in South Haven, the daughter of Franklin and Ragnhild (Holmquist) DeCook and has lived the majority of her life in the Bangor area. She was school librarian at Bangor Public Schools and was on the board of the Van Buren County Library Association, was a member of the Bangor Historical Society and helped with the Book of Bangor. She was a member of the Benevolence Chapter 256 Lawrence O.E.S., the Simpson United Methodist Church, MARSP, and was a member of the American Legion Auxiliary. Bev was also a Michigan Delegate for the Republican Party, and served on many committees for the City of Bangor. She loved to make quilts and White Oaks will be continuing their quilting program that Bev started.

She is survived by her 4 children, Rhonda (Ty) Gregory of Elkhart, IN, Victor Burlingame of Ft. Myers, FL, Jill (Scott) Kempinski of Bangor, Nancy (Dan) Grabovac of Bangor; 9 grandchildren; 7 great grandchildren; a sister-in-law, Gloria DeCook of Ft. Wayne, IN; and several nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her first husband, Robert Burlingame; second husband, James McLarty.

The family will meet friends from 10-12 noon Saturday, January 24, 2015 at the Simpson United Methodist Church, 507 Joy Street, Bangor, where the funeral service will be at 12:00 noon, with Pastor Thomas Davenport officiating.
