



Bonnie "Barney" McVey

Barney McVey passed away and went to Heaven to be with his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on August 20, 2024. He was born in Eugene, Oregon on March 20, 1940 to Elon McVey and Melba Ione (Walters) McVey.

Barney felt God's call to serve Him as a missionary, so he went to Bible School in Waukesha, Wisconsin, where he met his wife, Linda Damaske. Barney and Linda were married for 49 years before Linda went to be with the Lord. They joined New Tribes Mission (now Ethnos 360), completed their training and left for Senegal, West Africa where they served for 12-1/2 years.
