Passed away Thursday, March 28, 2024 at her home. Brenda was born February 14, 1945 in Pascola, MO the daughter of Frank and Edith (Davis) Fields, and grew up in the South Haven area. In 1965 she married Michael Balfour and moved to the Bangor area. She worked for South Haven Coil for over 30 years, five years with the Bangor Fire Department and Ambulance, and was the first female Mayor of Bangor. Brenda was a member of the American Legion Auxiliary. She loved her family, especially her grandchildren. Surviving are her daughter, Leah (Michael) Fall of Bangor; 2 grandchildren, Josiah (Sarah) Fall of Oshtemo, Makenna Fall of Bangor; brother, James (Peggy) Fields of South Haven; many nieces, nephews and cousins; and a special friend, Dorothy Carpenter. She was preceded in death by her husband, Michael in 2004; son, Baby Boy Balfour; and her parents. The family will gather for a celebration of Brenda's life, Monday, April 1st, from 11AM - 1PM at the American Legion in Bangor. Interment will be in Arlington Hill Cemetery at a later date. The family suggests memorials be made to the American Cancer Society or the Bangor American Legion.

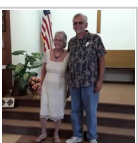
