



Calvin Stevens

April 14, 1924 - October 29, 2005

Passed away Saturday, October 29, 2005 at his home following a brief illness. Mr. Stevens was born April 14, 1924 in Kalamazoo to Edward J. and Frances (Claus) Stevens, Sr. He was a Veteran of WWII serving in the Navy as a gunner on a SBD dive bomber.
