



Catherine "Kate" Fry

January 22, 1916 - January 31, 2009

Catherine "Kate" Fry, age 93, of Bangor, passed away Saturday, January 31, 2009 at South Haven Nursing and Rehabilitation Community. Mrs. Fry was born January 22, 1916 in Hillside, Illinois, the daughter of Edward and Clara (Kellinger) Lee, and moved to the Breedsville area in 1930. On April 1, 1936, she married Chester W. Fry in Chicago. She formerly worked on the family fruit farm, and in 1959 she and her sister-in-law, Jean Fry, opened Fry Clothing, Bloomingdale. In 1965, she became a cosmetologist and opened Kate's Beauty Shop in her home, retiring in 1979 at which time she moved to Florida. Following Chester's death in 2000, she returned to the area to live with her son and daughter-in-law. Surviving are 3 sons, Thomas Fry of Breedsville, Michael (Mary Ann) Fry of Glendale, AZ, Dan (Sharon) Fry of Bangor; 5 grandchildren, Mark (Theresa) Fry, Melissa (Paul) Cooley, Diana Fry, Troy (Kim) Lincomfelt, Michelle Gillenwater; 8 great grandchildren; and a special friend, Ruth Frohreif. Besides her husband and parents, she was preceded in death by 6 brothers and 1 sister. The family will meet friends on Tuesday from 5-8 PM at the Bangor Chapel, D. L. Miller Funeral Home with a rosary at 7:30 PM. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated 11:00 AM Wednesday at Sacred Heart Church, Bangor with Fr. Gordon Greene celebrant.
