Clova Marie Woodley, age 90, of Bangor, passed away peacefully Thursday, October 4, 2007 in Bangor at her home in the presence of her family. Her family will meet friends Monday, October 8, 2007 from 2 - 4 PM and 7 - 9 PM at the Bangor Chapel, D. L. Miller Funeral Home. Funeral services will be held at 11:00 AM Tuesday, at the Simpson United Methodist Church, Bangor, with Rev. Thom Davenport officiating. Interment will follow at the Arlington Hill Cemetery, Bangor.
