November 20, 1945 - February 23, 2007

Clyde W. Crawford, age 61, of Gobles, died peacefully at Bronson Methodist Hospital, Kalamazoo, on Friday, February 23, 2007. Clyde began his honorable life on November 20, 1945 in Kalamazoo, the son of Wayne and Inez (Rock) Crawford. He graduated from Gobles High School and Western Michigan University. Clyde proudly joined the US Marines in 1964 and served in Viet Nam. In 1970, Jan Jeschke was fortunate to meet the man of her dreams and a loving relationship began. They were married on August 14, 1971 and from this union, they were blessed with a son, Chad Crawford, in 1973. Clyde's employment career began at Stoney's Ford in Gobles and later he entered the world of construction, first at Miller-Davis, and later joining in a partnership with the Kalleward Group, Kalamazoo where he dedicated the last 26 years. Clyde served on the Gobles School Board for 12 years and was inducted into the Gobles High School Athletic Hall of Fame in 1990. He had a passion for race cars, golf, and poker with his friends. Gobles is a much safer place because of Clyde's "safety meetings" with his buddies on Friday afternoons. Clyde loved his life on Brandywine Lake, creating memories with his loved ones. His family describes him as their "hero", and his love, determination, and legacy will never be forgotten. Surviving are his wife, Jan; son, Chad and Jane (McGuire) Crawford; his most precious grandchildren, Maggie and Max; his mother, Inez Bonnell; brother, Paul (Karen) Crawford, 3 sisters, Janice (Rich) Woodard, Connie Edwards, and Sharilyn Voorhees; his closest in-laws, Dolly Jeschke, Ed (Paula) Jeschke, Ken (Lynette) Jeschke,

Bette Jeschke; and a large extended family and many dear friends. Memorial services will be held 1:00 PM, Tuesday, February 27 at the Gobles Middle School Gymnasium.

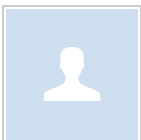

“ Dear Jan and family:

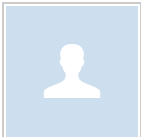
