Del was well known in the area for working at Stoney Ford during the 60's and 70's. In 1975 under the direction of Ben Munn he drilled his first well. He eventually he owned and operated Del's Well Drilling until his son, Dan, took over in 2006. The business is still in operation today, which Del remained active in until his death. Surviving are his 3 children, David Warden of Oklahoma, Tammy (Brian) Antisdell of Dowagiac, Dan (Karen) Warden of Gobles; 5 grandchildren, Michael Warden, Taylor Care, Alyssa Care, Myranda Care, Dade Warden; and 2 great grandchildren, Blake, and Brooklynn; and partner for many years, Linda Sheely. He was preceded in death by his parents, former wife, Vickie; 2 brothers, Dennis, and Donny.
