She was passionate about any project she cared about and led those projects with fierce advocacy. She also loved choosing books for family members, taking pictures of family and friends, scrapbooking and creating projects from those pictures that her family will cherish forever. Surviving are her husband, Dee; her children, Kayla (Steve Cederquist) Clement and Jason (Amy Noser) Clement; and her sister, Cheryl (Rich) Rumery.
