



## Dirk Wesseldyk

January 7, 1918 - April 16, 2006

Dirk J. Wesseldyk, of Allegan, left his earthly body to join his Heavenly Father in his eternal home Easter Sunday, April 16, 2006. Given his deep-seeded love of God, family thought it fitting that his passing occurred on the same day we celebrated the resurrection of his Savior.
