



## Donald O. Jorgensen

April 10, 1945 - October 11, 2025

Passed away at his home surrounded by his family on Saturday, October 11, 2025. Don farmed his family's bi-centennial farm and was very proud of its legacy. In the early years, Don milked cows, did chores, then went to school. He also served as the Cheshire Township Supervisor, was a licensed contractor, and on the side, he dug ponds, cleared land and did anything concrete related. His "happy toys" included his drag line, excavator, and bull dozer.
