Dorothy M. Moses, age 99, of Gobles, left us to meet her Savior January 28 at Life Care Center, Plainwell. She was born September 18, 1913 in Gobles across from the Methodist Church, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Fred Babbitt. She lived her entire life in the Gobles area, graduating from Gobles High School in 1932 and attended Western Normal College and could have been an elementary teacher. On November 1, 1941, she was united in marriage to Ossian B. Moses. They celebrated their 57th wedding anniversary in 1998, the year he passed away. Ossian, also a graduate of Northern College, Wisconsin, could have been a high school math teacher. They purchased the Goblesville News and were owners and publishers for 40 years, retiring in 1977. Dorothy was a member of Bethany Presbyterian Church, a volunteer in many services in the church, school and community. She was always close to the Gobles school, holding many positions in the PTA, and was president when the first banquet was held in the new school. She was proud of family and friends whom she felt everyone was close to her.
