



## Dorothy E. Heinze

August 26, 1924 - March 23, 2009

Dorothy E. Heinze, age 84, of South Haven passed away Monday, March 23, 2009 at her home.

Dorothy was born August 26, 1924 in South Haven the daughter of Gustav and Emilie Heinze and was one of nine children. She graduated from South Haven High School in 1943 and then lived in La Porte, Indiana where she worked at the Kingsman Ammunition plant during the war. She returned to South Haven and worked at General Telephone Company, South Haven for 10 years and then moved to Santa Monica, California where she worked at the Telephone Company in East Los Angeles as an operator for a short time.
