Dorothy M. Youker, age 89, of Kalamazoo, formerly of Brandywine Lake, Gobles died Friday, October 27, 2006 at Borgess Nursing Home. Dorothy was born Aug. 31, 1917 in Richmond, VA, the daughter of George and Louise (Bittenger) Morgan. She taught dancing and danced professionally early in her life, having attended the Goodman Theatre at the Art Institute in Chicago. Dorothy married John Mason Youker on Nov. 24, 1943 and they resided in Wheaton, IL for many years.
