Passed away Thursday, February 16, 2012 in Kalamazoo. Doug was born April 4, 1917 in Three Rivers, the son of Norman W. and Olive Marie Garrison. Douglas served in the US Army Air Corps as a gunnery instructor during WWII. He is a graduate of Alma College and holds a master's degree from U of M. He was a lifelong educator and served as elementary principal in Bangor for many years. Sports were very important in his life, from coaching little league to following the U of M teams. Golf and tennis were favorite past times. Doug was also a long time member of the Bangor Kiwanis Club. He was united in marriage to Clara Jeanne Polas on September 19, 1942 and was a devout member of Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church of Bangor. Doug and Jeanne enjoyed travel and spent nearly 30 winters in Panama City Beach, FL.
