



Eloise Fay Johnson

March 15, 1919 - July 10, 2012

ELOISE FAY "LOIS" JOHNSON, age 93, of Gobles, formerly of Benton Harbor and Breedsville, died at Rose Arbor in Kalamazoo on July 10, 2012. She was born in 1919, in Scottville, Michigan, the last surviving child of Clinton Clark Parker and Elinor Belle (Hardenbrook) Parker of Breedsville. She was married to the late Arthur Carl Johnson of Breedsville, was a beloved wife and mother, and was known as "Grandma" to her four generations of descendants. She served as an adult leader in the Girl Scouts, as an officer and flag bearer in the VFW Auxiliary, and as secretary of the Parent Teachers Organization. Eloise was an excellent cook, enjoyed canning, and was a very accomplished seamstress. She lived and worked in Benton Harbor for many years and retired from Sanitary Cleaners as a drapery finisher. She was then active in several retirement clubs in the area, and enjoyed dancing her entire life. In addition to her parents and husband, Eloise was preceded in death by her brothers Harmon, Chester, Samuel, and Theodore Parker, and her sisters Ladaura "Dora" Fiedler, Elizabeth Hayden, Nora Iva Buskirk, and Clara Joyce Keil. She is survived by her children Ted (Donna) Johnson of Hartford, A.L. "Lonny" Johnson of Grand Junction, Carl (Miriam) Johnson of Dewey, Arizona, Louise (Wayne) Nelson of Gobles, Elizabeth (Ed Bowen) Taylor of Bloomingdale, and Chester Johnson of Grand Junction. Also surviving are three honorary children, Signe Johnson of Holland, Lois Roberts of Bangor, and JoAnn Cappetto of Pullman, along with 11 grandchildren and numerous great and great-great grandchildren.

The family will receive visitors from 10-11 AM Friday at the Bangor Chapel, D.L. Miller Funeral Home where the funeral service will be 11:00 AM with Pastor Duane Jones officiating.
