Florence Ella Goodrich, who has been residing in San Clemente, CA, died March 21st at 11:24 am. She was 92. Born October 1, 1920, to George and Ella Rouse of Bloomingdale, Michigan, she was the youngest of six children. She graduated from Bloomingdale High School in 1938. 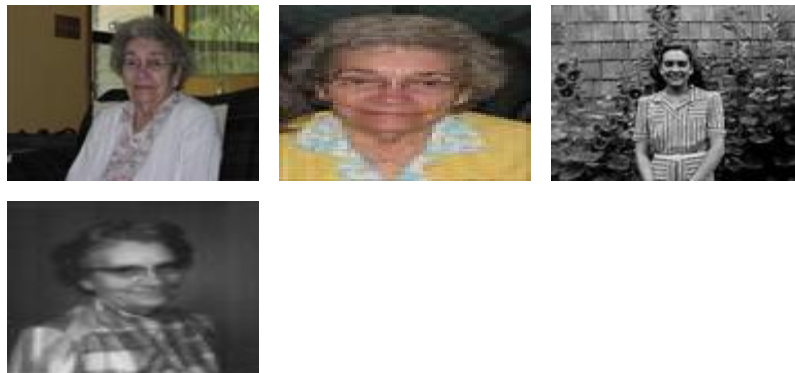
