He was listening to a football game when Pearl Harbor was bombed, and then left high school in his senior year to join and serve in the US Army. Fraser went on to graduate from Cornell University and then in 1980 completed his MBA at Western Michigan University. His first job was with Proctor and Gamble on Staten Island, and he retired from IBM. In 1996, he and wife Shirley founded Apple-A-Day Farm, in Bangor.
