Gerald M. Fritsche, age 90, of South Haven, passed away Saturday, August 30, 2008 at the South Haven Nursing & Rehabilitation Community. Mr. Fritsche was born August 25, 1918 in South Haven, the son of Henry and Marie Fritsche. He was an Army veteran of WWII.
