Gerald M. Springett, age 81, of Bangor, passed away Wednesday, December 26, 2007 at Countryside Nursing and Rehabilitation Community, South Haven. Gerald was born November 10, 1926 in Bangor, the son of Merle and Flora (Whiteman) Springett. He has lived all of his life in the Bangor area and graduated from Bangor Public Schools. Jerry was a veteran of the US Army during WW II, was the former owner of the Sinclair Gas Station, Bangor, worked as Transportation Supervisor and mechanic for the Bangor Public Schools for 20 years, and owned and operated Jerry's Gargage, Bangor until his retirement. He was a longtime member of Simpson United Methodist Church, Bangor; the Black River Muzzle Loaders, Bangor, the Hartford Sportsman Club, and the Wilcox, Eastman, Salinas American Legion Post 160, Bangor. Surviving are his wife, Mary Jane, whom he married in 1950; 3 children, Janet (Ron) Williams of Midland, Darrel (Diane) Springett of Grand Rapids, Ronda (Tim) Troutman of Byron Center; 6 grandchildren; 2 brothers, Marshall Springett of Bloomingdale and Clair Springett of Bangor. He was preceded in death by a son, Michael Springett; his parents; and 3 sisters. According to his wishes, cremation has taken place and a memorial service will be held 11:00 AM Saturday, December 29, 2007, at Simpson United Methodist Church with Pastor Thomas Davenport officiating.
