



## Hubert A. Brouwer, Sr.

February 21, 1911 - May 30, 2011

Hubert A. Brouwer, Sr., age 100, of Gobles, passed away Monday, May 30, 2011 at Allegan General Hospital. Hubert was born Feb. 21, 1911 in Dorr, MI, the son of Thomas and Frederika (Buss) Brouwer, and has lived the majority of his life in the Gobles area. He was a member of the Gobles United Methodist Church, Gobles Fire Dept., and the Odd Fellows. Hubert loved gardening, fishing, camping, bowling, square dancing, and was a very active person.
