Jane Scamehorn, age 91, of Bloomingdale, passed away Saturday, April 11, 2009 at Rose Arbor Hospice Residence, Kalamazoo. Jane was born August 17, 1917 in Bloomingdale where she has lived most of her life. She was involved with the American Red Cross and in 2002, along with her husband, George Jr., was named Bloomingdale Citizen of the Year. Jane was also actively involved with the Bloomingdale Historical Society, the remodeling of the Depot, and many other local activities. She was an active member of the Bloomingdale Methodist Church and a former Sunday School teacher; she also volunteered at the V.A. Medical Center in Battle Creek. Surviving are a daughter, Pamela (Stan) Rimkus of Gobles; 1 granddaughter, Tiffany (Chris) Quatermus of Plainwell; 1 grandson, Rich Rimkus of Gobles; and 2 great-grandchildren, Kristen and Ryan Quatermus.
