Jean Liggett passed away February 24th at age 90 in Tallahassee, Florida. She was born February 26, 1926 in the Chicago suburb of Oak Park, Illinois to Anjelica (Anne) Kolar and Merle Vernon. After a few years in New Jersey, during the Depression the family moved to a farmstead near Bangor, Michigan. She began her career as an X-ray technician at South Haven hospital. There she met Clyde Thomas, a Michigan State Trooper, and they married in 1948. They lived in South Haven, Bangor, Gaylord and in 1956 moved to Niles, Michigan. Jean was widowed in 1963. She started working in the bookstore at Niles Senior High School and retired 22 years later as secretary to the principal. In 1975 Jean married Wayne Liggett of South Bend and they spent 25 years together. After Wayne's death, Jean moved to Tallahassee, Florida to be with family. Jean spent the last several years in the Westminster Oaks continuing care community. Jean is survived by one son, Michael Thomas, daughter-in-law Laurie, and one granddaughter, Katarina.
