Johannes (Joe) VanEk, age 90, of Gobles, was called home by his Heavenly Father on Thursday, May 9, 2013. He was born December 14, 1922, in the Netherlands. He came to America when he was 2 and settled with his family in the Grand Rapids area. He was a veteran of World War II serving in the United States Army. In his younger years, he had a passion for motorcycles. Together, Joe and Evelyn have traveled to all 50 states and Europe. They also shared a love of birds and nature, especially Hummingbirds and Baltimore Orioles. Joe served as an elder and deacon in a number of churches and is currently a member of Merson Church in Gobles. He loved music and was a talented harmonica player, playing at church and for his grandchildren.
