Clarence and I ran together for a couple of years in the mid sixties. What can I say?

Clarence's parents let me stay in their home , in one of those high rise "projects", in East Chicago, I found Laura and her husband, Clarence, to be gracious hosts, though I doubt if they didn't get just a little static from the neighbors for having some white kid in the building, :)

I was fortunate enough to be hanging around when Clarence's sister, Sandra, came home from England for a family visit. It was fun to see her in Clarence and Clarence in her. Their parents did a job to be proud of with those two kids, and it couldn't have been easy. :)

My wife and I live in a ranch style home in the middle of a 12 acre walnut orchard. Beyond the orchard are vineyards and then the mountains. It is a very rural area. I often have more than one occasion to sit out on the back deck in the afternoon and sip a glass (or two) of wine and think about my life's adventures. Clarence comes up more often than not!

I would love to tell the family of Clarence's bravery. It puts me to shame to this day!

I have no idea if Clarence is still alive today, though the obituary would suggest that he is. I found this obituary on line while searching for his whereabouts. I recognized the names immediately, which is no small achievement, at my age. :)

*Clarence, if you are still out there, I married the Native American lady. We lasted about ten years and we have a daughter and a son. They are reservation rats, but highly successful rats. Michael (what a surprise) is the Tribal Chairman and a big dog in the Native American Gaming industry. Melinda runs the tribal health and senior citizen departments for the tribe. I have remarried, about 29 years ago, and my wife and I share the family gatherings with my ex and our children. The tribe seems to think I am still cool and I always feel welcome.*

*Life has been exciting, but I wouldn't have it any other way.*

*Hope to here from you, Clarence, or your Kids. Thrilled to see that there is a Clarence Royster III. That was at the top of your bucket list, even as a young man!*

*Remember Roy Head and "treat Her Like A Lady"? I'll never forget that night. It took me a while to finally understand what went on that night. It was special!*
