



## Mervin O. Yeider

Mervin O. Yeider, age 86, of Bangor, passed away Wednesday, May 5, 2010 at South Haven Nursing and Rehabilitation Community. Mervin was born July 27, 1923 in Bangor Township the son of Levi and Reta (Sternaman) Yeider and had been a lifelong resident. He graduated from Bangor High School, was a veteran of the US Army during WW II, and had retired from Everett Piano Company, South Haven. Mervin was one of the founders of the Bangor Little League, and was a former member of the Bangor Community Fire Board and the Coloma EMS Board, a ham radio operator, and a lifetime member of the Bangor American Legion and VFW. Surviving are his wife, Peggy, whom he married August 10, 1946; 2 sons, David (Laura) Yeider of Kalamazoo, Dennis (Cynthia) Yeider of Wheaton, Illinois; 6 grandchildren, Brent, Ryan, Patrick, Samantha, Lindsey, Alexandra Yeider; 2 great grandchildren, Evan and Lily; 1 sister, Shirley King of South Haven.
