Paul D. Kelley, age 93, of South Haven and Harlingen, TX, passed away October 26, 2012, peacefully at home surrounded by his family. Paul was born April 30, 1919 on a farm in Casco Township, the son of Clifford and Margaret (Rasmussen) Kelly. He was retired from Bohn Aluminum and Brass Company after 35 years of service.
