Everything he did; whether it was a chess move or a math problem, a candid photo at a family reunion or dancing with his children during a 'disco break', Chicago 'steppin' or playing the dozens (a roast session), Bid Whist or Spades, building a porch from scratch or landscaping a garden, captivating a room with a joke or a story and being the life of the party or mentoring the young men and boys in his family; all would say Paul Jr. did it better than most. PJ was more than talented, he was virtuosic and genius at almost anything he

put his mind and energy to. He was SPECIAL!! And he KNEW IT!! Growing up on the south side of Chicago during the civil rights era PJ had to fight and learned that even though he was skinny, he could and would throw down if he needed to, being on the vanguard of school integration PJ was bused to a predominantly white school for the academically gifted. While facing racism and discrimination he still excelled in his academic and social circles. During his senior year, his family moved to Gobles, MI, another environment where he was one of few integrating the school system for the first time ever. Cremation has taken place.
