He attended the University of Wisconsin and was a devout Green Bay Packer fan. Paul was later employed by Schulmerich Bells in Pennsylvania for the next 37 years. He was the radiological officer for Van Buren County for many years and taught Sky Warn weather spotting classes through the county emergency management office. Paul was also a "Trekkie", even going to a few conventions over the years.
