



Robert "Bob" Black

March 1, 1951 - April 9, 2012

Robert "Bob" Black, age 61, of South Haven, passed away Monday, April 9, 2012 at Rose Arbor Hospice, Kalamazoo. Bob was born March 1, 1951 in Jackson, MI, the son of William and Eileen (Horthrop) Black and has lived the past seven years in the South Haven area, where he was the South Haven Public Schools Superintendent, and was active in the community. In 1969 he graduated from Jackson Parkside, received his BS from Hillsdale College in 1973, and completed his Masters in Educational Leadership at Western Michigan University in 1985. While at Hillsdale College he played baseball and football, and met his wife Cathy whom he married in 1976. Bob started his teaching career in Albion, MI teaching fourth grade, and coaching high school football and baseball. In 1989 he became Principal at North Adams-Jerome Elementary School, and in 1995 was named Superintendent. In 1998 he became Superintendent at Dundee Community Schools, and in 2006 he became Superintendent at the South Haven Public Schools. He was involved with many community activities and organizations but never missed any of his children's sporting events or school activities. Bob enjoyed all sports but especially his Tigers, Lions, Red Wings and Michigan football. He also enjoyed playing golf with his sons. Surviving are his wife, Cathy; 3 children, Andy Black of Miami, FL, Dan (Allie) Black of Bowling Green, OH, Libby Black of Daytona Beach, FL; granddaughter, Madison Black; sister-in-law, Kathie Black; aunt, Jane Gallas; 11 nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by a brother, Thomas Black; his parents; and an uncle, Alex. The family will

meet friends from 12 Noon until 1:00 PM at the Listiak Auditorium in the South Haven High School where the funeral service will be held at 1:00 PM Saturday, April 14, 2012.
