



## Rudy Duane Sauer

January 3, 1936 - October 3, 2024

Rudy Sauer, age 88, passed away at home on October 3, 2024. A prominent farmer in the Bloomingdale, Michigan area, he and his wife established Sauer Orchards in 1963. His lifetime as a proud farmer included growing and harvesting apples, tart cherries, sweet cherries, peaches, plums, pumpkins, asparagus and various other fruits and vegetables. He initiated selling the farm's fruit at the Eastern Market in Detroit, which currently continues. Rudy passed away during Sauer Orchards apple harvest, and even though he had been retired for years, the morning of his passing happened to be market day, and Rudy dressed accordingly, even wearing his cap. Rudy served on the Board of Directors at Bloomingdale Communications for approximately 30 years. He enjoyed fishing, pheasant hunting, mushroom hunting, and looked forward to the annual hunting cabin trip up north with his sons. Along with fishing and hunting, Rudy loved playing cards with his family and friends. Rudy was born January 3, 1936 to Wilbur and Florene Sauer. He married the former Sharon Remington on July 6, 1957. Surviving are his wife of 67 years, Sharon. His sons Randy (Janet) Sauer, Jeff (Lorraine) Sauer, Greg (Sue) Sauer, and his daughter Tammy (Pete) Myotte.
