Russell W. Pomeroy, age 72, of Gobles, passed away peacefully at his home on May 31, 2021 surrounded by his family. Russell was born March 14, 1949 in Allegan, the son of Kenneth and Joyce (Leversee) Pomeroy, and had lived in the Kendall and Gobles area his entire life. Russ served in the US Army in Vietnam for 22 months as an Army Corp Engineer. He was an avid fisherman, hunter, and loved all things outdoors. Russell was 37 and a half years sober in AA. He was a member of Gobles United Methodist Church, South Haven Chapter of the Steelheaders, River Bend Boat Club, and the Local 131 IBEW. Russ loved helping others & volunteered with the Injured Soldiers Project. Of all of his hobbies, getting into mischief with his children and grandchildren was by far his favorite. Surviving are his wife, Chris, whom he married Aug 5, 1972; 4 children, Todd (Wanda) Pomeroy of Mesa, AZ, Sara (Jeff) Bartells of Kalamazoo, Jesse Pomeroy of Kendall, Chapin Pomeroy of Mason; 4 grandchildren, Kenneth Pomeroy, Cooper and Colby Bartells, Madelyn Pomeroy; sister, Cindy (David) Peterson of Bloomingdale; and many nieces, nephews and cousins. He was preceded in death by his parents and sister, Judy Gunter.
