April 30, 1938 - June 8, 2019

Sandra Lee Valentine, 81, of Bangor, MI passed away peacefully at Bronson Methodist Hospital, Kalamazoo after a long battle with health concerns, surrounded by her family. Sandra was born on April 30, 1938 in Bangor, the daughter of John and Virginia Sherrick, delivered by her grandfather, Dr. Edwin G. Low. Sandra was a graduate of Bangor High School, a lifetime member of Simpson United Methodist Church of Bangor, a long time member of Van Buren County Republican Women's Club, a member of Friends of the Library, an honorary lifetime member of Bangor Historical Society and a member of Van Buren County Genealogical Society. 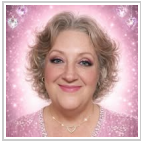
