Shirley Ann Lipford, age 82, of Bangor, passed away suddenly on Tuesday, July 18, 2017. Shirley was born January 12, 1935, in Blytheville, AR the daughter of Leonard and Brucie (Barnes) White. 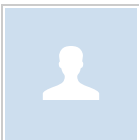
