Susan Bray passed away on March 14, 2025, at Kairos Dwelling in Kalamazoo, MI with her family by her side. Susan was born on February 6, 1966, in South Haven, Michigan, the daughter of Harold and Evonne McFarlin. She attended Bangor Schools and graduated in 1984. After high school, she moved to Salt Lake City with her high school sweetheart, William “Bill” Bray. They were married on September 19, 1987, in Las Vegas, where they lived for five years. They moved back to Michigan in 1992 where they remained and raised their family. She worked for Bronson Hospital as a billing analyst. When she was not working, she spent her time gardening in her flower bed, going camping, golfing, traveling, and cooking for her family, which was her greatest joy. Surviving are her husband, Bill Bray; a daughter, Samantha (Cody Tone) Bray of Cassopolis; a son, Will Bray of Kalamazoo; and her grandkids, Colton and Jettson Tone. She is also survived by her mom, Evonne McFarlin; two siblings, Denese Lewis and David McFarlin, along with many nieces, nephews and friends. She was preceded in death by her father, Harold McFarlin, and her in-laws, George and Eleanor. The family will receive friends on Friday, March 21, 2025, from 11 a.m. to 12 p.m. at the Bangor Chapel of the D.L. Miller Funeral Home. 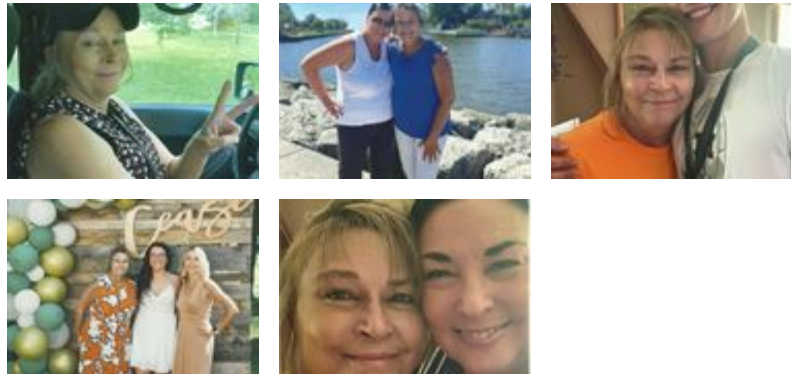
