He was preceded in death by his loving wife, Carole Jean Moore in 2014; 2 sisters, Kathryn Goss and Jean Moore. The family will meet friends from 10-11AM Tuesday, February 4, at the Calvary Missionary Baptist Church on Cherry Street in South Haven where the memorial service will follow at 11 AM, Brother Mick Schmidt officiating. According to his wishes cremation has taken place and burial will be at a later time in Monks Cemetery, Geneva Township.
