



Vance L. Kincaid

November 11, 1921 - October 14, 2015

Vance Kincaid, beloved husband, father, grandfather, entered God's Kingdom Oct. 14, 2015 at age 93, surrounded at home by his family. He was born in Argonne, WI on Nov. 11, 1921, Armistice Day, to Leonard and Gerlee Mae Kincaid. He was a student at Northern Michigan College, Marquette, MI, when Dec. 7, 1941 WWII broke out. He enlisted in the US Air Force. 1st Lt. Kincaid served his country for 8 1/2 years as a pilot, navigator, and administrative officer. He was stationed in the Panama Canal Zone, Galapagos Islands (submarine patrol), Alaska (Strategic Air Command), Guam, Japan and many US Air Force Bases. Medals awarded, Air Medal, American Campaign Medal, WWII Victory Medal, Army of Occupation Medal (Japan). He met and married his wife, Gladys Hicks, at Elmhurst College, Elmhurst, IL. They celebrated 64 years together on May 12. In 1955, they moved to a farm in Gobles, MI and feel it is the most wonderful place on earth. Vance co-developed The Sugarloaf Trailer Park in the 1960's. Most of his working life was in construction as a supervisor, estimator for the M.W. VanderVeen Construction Co. In retirement, he loved raising Belted Galloway beef cattle with his children, helping in family and church projects, being a 4-H and Boy Scout Leader, DAV member and voting in elections. Surviving are his wife, Gladys; their children, Michelle Thomas of Allegan, Vance II of Okemos, MI, Holly Thomas (David) of Gobles, Kreg (Lisa) of Gobles; grandchildren, great and great great grandchildren. Preceding him in death were his son, Ty, and one brother and four sisters. A graveside service will be held at Earl Cemetery, 3
